

RINGING ON HOLT ISLAND 19 -20 December 2017

The weather was still and mostly murky with some brightness on the 19th. The Island has a lot of standing water for the recent rain and snow, indeed there was still odd little patches of snow where the sun could not get.

The catch was modest but the numbers of Blue Tits and Great Tits was back up and accounted for the bulk of the catch. The Great Spotted Woodpecker was one that was ringed in May 2016.

There are still quite a number of Goldcrests around particularly towards the churchyard side, the one we caught was a this year's bird

No rats were seen but at least three black squirrels were present some near the Holt.
