

RINGING ON HOLT ISLAND 11 – 12 June 2018

The weather on the first day was sunny and hot and on the second overcast, both were still days.

Large numbers of young birds were caught including Song Thrush, Garden warbler, Blackcap, Reed Warbler and Greenfinch. Many of the Blue Tits and Great Tits were from our nesting boxes including Box 8 (3); Box 9 (2); Box 14 (2); Box 20 (8); and Box 22 (4).

Amongst the other thing noted on the island were Water Forget-me-not, Red Admiral, Lots of Banded Demoiselles and a Scarce Chaser.
