

Ringling on Holt Island 13th July 2018

A short early morning session of ringing with five nets. The morning was overcast but not cold.

A large number of new Great Tits were caught. The area is supporting a significant number of Great Tits and Blue Tits most of which are just beginning their post- juvenile moult. Good numbers of Reed Warblers were also caught, mostly adults one of which was in body moult

Due to the overcast weather not many butterflies were seen but there were Large White, Small White and Comma. A few Banded Demoiselles were also seen.

Several areas of Greater Dodder were noted, one on the Meadow, one in the Reed Bed and one along the river
