The weather was cool but sunny, ringing took place from dawn until 9.00am with five nets aiming for warblers. There a number of singing Chiffchaffs, Blackcaps, Reed Warblers and Sedge Warblers.

Of the re-traps the most interesting was a Reed Warbler that was ringed on 26 May 2016 and has been re-caught seven times in all the subsequent years.

A cuckoo was heard as it flew along the river.

On arriving at the Island a Hedgehog was seen several times on the boardwalk near the backwater.
