

RINGING REPORT FOR HOLT ISLAND 8TH AND 9TH SEPTEMBER 2020

The weather was fine on the afternoon of the 8th but overcast on the morning of the 9th. It was warm both days. There was not a great deal of bird movement on the morning of 9th but overall a good number of birds were caught. It was particularly nice to catch the Cetti's Warbler which was caught three times all told, it was generally skulking around. We also caught our first Willow Warbler of the year.

Some of the more interesting re-traps included a Blue Tit from box 9 and another from box 12 (2019). The Great Spotted Woodpecker was ringed in April this year.

Although we only caught 3 Chiffchaffs there were a lot around but mostly high up in the trees.

There were a number of black squirrels around also plenty of Small White Butterflies, some Red Admirals and one Peacock, also many Migrant Hawker Dragonflies and Southern Hawkers.
