WICKEN FEN (BIRD RINGING) GROUP **Brief news for January 2016**

There were netting sessions at the Fen on 13 different days in January. The St. Edmund's Fen/Education area (Compartments 30 & 31) was used on all these days, with the Reedbed also receiving a brief visit on the 6th. The month's ringing total was 134; a further 226 different birds were retrapped, so the overall total for the month was 360. The totals and the breakdown are very similar to those of January 2015.
