WICKEN FEN (BIRD RINGING) GROUP Brief news for February 2016

The Group's indoor meeting, although most successful, seems to have induced a certain torpor, so although there were netting sessions at the Fen on 13 different days in February, the catching was poor. The St. Edmund's Fen/Education area (Compartments 30 & 31) was used on 10 days, Gallops (Compartment 21) on 4, and the Reedbed (Compartments 51, 52, 53) on one. The month's ringing total was 140; a further 178 different birds were retrapped, so the overall total for the month was only 318.
