## WICKEN FEN (BIRD RINGING) GROUP Brief news for April 2016

There were netting sessions at the Fen on 11 different days in April, although some of these were small-scale and targeted at Willow Warblers. The St. Edmund's Fen/Education area was used for netting on just 4 days, Gallops on 2 and the Reedbed on 5. The month's ringing total was 122; a further 117 different birds were retrapped, so the overall total for the month was 239.
