## WICKEN FEN (BIRD RINGING) GROUP News for January 2007

There were 19 ringing sessions at the Fen in January, on 17 different days. The St. Edmund's Fen/Education area was used for 8 of these sessions, Area B on 6 and the Reedbed on 5. The month's ringing total was 224, other birds retrapped numbered 306, so a total of 530 different birds were handled during the month. In the list below, the first figure is the number ringed, the second the number of different birds retrapped.

Some elderly birds were retrapped during the month:

Long-tailed Tit OM4185 had been ringed on 22.8.2000, retrapped on 28.1.2007 Blue Tit P093810 had been ringed on 30.6.2002, retrapped on 4..1.2007 Bullfinch N590489 had been ringed on 18.7.2000, retrapped on 13.1.2007 Reed Bunting P214091 had been ringed on 11.12.2001, retrapped on 31.1.2007

A Blue Tit (T940490) that had been ringed at the Reedbed at 08.20am on January 28<sup>th</sup>, had flown up to near the Visitor Centre by 10.05am the same day.

A Blackcap (N590854) that we ringed on November 4<sup>th</sup> was retrapped on January 28<sup>th</sup>. Blackcaps, mainly from Germany and other North European countries, have only recently started to spend their winters in Britain. N590854 was probably such a bird.

Jack Snipe one on January 29<sup>th</sup>.

Woodcock recorded on 6 days in the month.

Black-tailed Godwit 3 on January 29<sup>th</sup>. Stonechat 2 on January 21<sup>st</sup>.
