WICKEN FEN (BIRD RINGING) GROUP Brief news for June 2007

There was ringing sessions at the Fen on 18 different days in June. The St. Edmund's Fen/Education area (comps 30 & 31) was used for 7 sessions, Area B (comps 20, 21 & 23) on 3, the Reedbed (comps 51, 52 & 53) on 7, Bakers Fen (comps 101-107) on 3 and Burwell Fens (comp 201) on 4. The month's ringing total was 443; other birds retrapped numbered 131, so a total of 574 different birds were handled during the month. In the list below, the first figure is the number ringed, the second the number of different birds retrapped

The 3 Jackdaws were nestlings in a box at Burwell Fen, and are a new species for the WFG list (which now stands at 98 species). The two "retrapped" Barn Owls were actually controls of the adults breeding at Guinea Hall and Burwell Fen, We have yet to hear of their origin.
