WICKEN FEN (BIRD RINGING) GROUP Brief news for September 2007

There were ringing sessions at the Fen on 22 different days in September. The St. Edmund's Fen/Education area (Compartments 30 & 31) was used on 15 different days, the Reedbed (Compartments 51, 52 & 53) on 9, Tubney Fen (Compartments 300-310) on 2 and Baker's Fen for one. The month's ringing total was 646; a further 197 different birds were retrapped, so the overall total for the month was 843.
