## WICKEN FEN（BIRD RINGING）GROUP Brief news for January 2008

There were ringing sessions at the Fen on 14 different days in January．The St．Edmund＇s Fen／Education area（Compartments $30 \& 31$ ）was used on 9 days，the Reedbed（Compartments $51,52 \& 53$ ）on 5，and Gallop＇s（Compartments 20， 21 and 23）on 2．The month＇s ringing total was 157；a further 303 different birds were retrapped，so the overall total for the month was 460 ．Individual species totals（the first figure new birds，the second retraps）were：
