WICKEN FEN (BIRD RINGING) GROUP Brief news for July 2008

There were netting sessions at the Fen on 13 different days in July. The St. Edmund's Fen/Education area (Compartments 30 & 31) was used on 8 days and the Reedbed (Compartments 51, 52 & 53) on 6. In addition, there were a few visits devoted to nest-finding and nestling ringing. The month's ringing total was 267; a further 78 different birds were retrapped, so the overall total for the month was 345.
