## WICKEN FEN (BIRD RINGING) GROUP Brief news for August 2008

There were netting sessions at the Fen on 16 different days in August. The St. Edmund's Fen/Education area (Compartments 30 & 31) was used on 12 days and the Reedbed (Compartments 51, 52 & 53) on 9. The month's ringing total was 587; a further 106 different birds were retrapped, so the overall total for the month was 693. Individual species totals (the first figure new birds, the second retraps) were:
