## WICKEN FEN (BIRD RINGING) GROUP <br> Brief news for February 2009

There were netting sessions at the Fen on 12 different days in February. The St. Edmund's Fen/Education area (Compartments 30 \& 31) was used on 9 days, the Reedbed (Compartments 51, $52 \& 53$ ) on 4, the Priory Farm area (Compartment 104) on 2 and Gallops (Compartment 21) on 2. The month's ringing total was 186; a further 233 different birds were retrapped, so the overall total for the month was 419 . Individual species totals (the first figure new birds, the second retraps) were:
