## WICKEN FEN (BIRD RINGING) GROUP Brief news for November 2009

There were netting sessions at the Fen on 16 different days in November. The St. Edmund's Fen/Education area (Compartments 30 & 31) was used on 8 days, Gallops (Compartment 21) on 4 and the Reedbed (Compartments 51, 52 & 53) on 10. The month's ringing total was 270; a further 198 different birds were retrapped, so the overall total for the month was 468.
