WICKEN FEN (BIRD RINGING) GROUP Brief news for January 2010

There were netting sessions at the Fen on 14 different days in December. The St. Edmund's Fen/Education area (Compartments 30 & 31) was used on 11 days, Gallops (Compartment 21) on 1, the Reedbed (Compartments 51, 52 & 53) on 2 and the Priory Farm area (Compartment 104) on 2. The month's ringing total was 159; a further 262 different birds were retrapped, so the overall total for the month was 421.
