WICKEN FEN (BIRD RINGING) GROUP Brief news for March 2011

There were netting sessions at the Fen on 15 different days in March. The St. Edmund's Fen/Education area (Compartments 30 & 31) was used on 6 days, Gallops/Sedge Fen (Compartments 15 & 21) on 5, and the Reedbed (Compartments 51, 52 and 53) on 7. The month's ringing total was 175; a further 233 different birds were retrapped, so the overall total for the month was 408.
