## WICKEN FEN (BIRD RINGING) GROUP Brief news for April 2011

There were netting sessions at the Fen on 20 different days in April. The St. Edmund's Fen/Education area (Compartments 30 & 31) was used on 12 days, Gallops/Sedge Fen (Compartments 15 & 21) on 6, and the Reedbed (Compartments 51, 52 and 53) on 8. In addition, attempts were made to catch birds on some "non-traditional" area of the Fen, as well as the wide-ranging ringing of nestlings. The month's ringing total was 228; a further 217 different birds were retrapped, so the overall total for the month was 445.
