WICKEN FEN (BIRD RINGING) GROUP Brief news for August 2011

There was ringing activity at the Fen on 23 different days in August. The St. Edmund's Fen/Education area (Compartments 30 & 31) was used for netting on 5 days, Gallops/Sedge Fen (Compartments 15 & 21) on 5 and the Reedbed (Compartments 51, 52 & 53) on 18. The month's ringing total was 1323, a further 145 birds were retrapped, so the overall total of birds handled in the month was 1468. The first figure below is the ringing total; the second is the retraps. Individual species totals were:
