WICKEN FEN (BIRD RINGING) GROUP Brief news for January 2012

There were netting sessions at the Fen on 14 different days in January. The St. Edmund's Fen/Education area (Compartments 30 & 31) was used on 8 days, Gallops/A2 area (Compartments 15 and 21) on 3 and the Reedbed (Compartments 51, 52 & 53) on 4. The month's ringing total was 130; a further 239 different birds were retrapped, so the overall total for the month was 369.
