## WICKEN FEN (BIRD RINGING) GROUP Brief news for July 2012

There was mist-net ringing activity at the Fen on 14 different days in July. The St. Edmund's Fen/Education area (Compartments $30 \& 31$ ) was used for netting on 7 days, Gallops/Sedge Fen (Compartments $15 \& 21$ ) on 5 and the Reedbed (Compartments 51, $52 \& 53$ ) on 5. The month's ringing total was 343 , a further 132 birds were retrapped, so the overall total of birds handled in the month was 475 . The first figure below is the ringing total; the second is the retraps. Individual species totals were:
