## WICKEN FEN (BIRD RINGING) GROUP Brief news for July 2013

There was mist-net ringing activity at the Fen on 14 different days in July. The St. Edmund's Fen/Education area (Compartments 30 & 31) was used for netting on 5 days, the Reedbed (Compartments 51, 52 & 53) on 8, and Westmere on 2 Additionally there were 9 days on which nestling birds were ringed. The month's ringing total was 472, a further 106 birds were retrapped, so the overall total of birds handled in the month was 578. The first figure below is the ringing total; the second is the retraps. Individual species totals were:
