WICKEN FEN (BIRD RINGING) GROUP Brief news for May 2015

There were netting sessions at the Fen on 11 different days in May. The St. Edmund's Fen/Education area was used on 6 days, the Reedbed on 5 and Gallops on 3. On several other days, nestling birds were ringed without the use of the nets, in open nests or in the large and small nestboxes. The month's ringing total was 245, a further 143 birds were retrapped, so the overall total of birds handled in the month was 388. The first figure below is the ringing total, the second is the retraps. Individual species totals were:
