There was mist-netting activity at the Fen on 9 different days in July. The St. Edmund's Fen/Education area was used for netting on 7 days, and the Reedbed on 3. There was just a single (large) nestbox visit. The month's ringing total was 272 - a further 86 birds were retraps; making a total of 358.
