WICKEN FEN (BIRD RINGING) GROUP Brief news for February 2017

There were netting sessions at the Fen on only 8 different days in February, and the catching remained poor. The St. Edmund's Fen/Education area was used on 4 days, as were both the Reedbed and Gallops. The month's ringing total was only 66, but a further 185 different birds were retrapped, so the overall total for the month was 251.
