## WICKEN FEN (BIRD RINGING) GROUP Brief news for April 2017

There were netting sessions at the Fen on 16 different days in April. The St. Edmund's Fen/Education area was used for netting on 10 days, Gallops on 3 and the Reedbed on 5.
