## WICKEN FEN (BIRD RINGING) GROUP Brief news for January 2018

There were netting sessions at the Fen on only 6 different days in January - a reduction on recent years. But January netting is often unrewarding, so less frequent visits inevitable. The St. Edmund's Fen/Education area was used on 3 days, the Reedbed on 2 and Gallops 3 (this was where the best catching was). The month's ringing total was 86 (slightly more than 2017!); a further 162 different birds were retrapped, so the overall total for the month was 248.
