WICKEN FEN (BIRD RINGING) GROUP Brief news for February 2018

There were netting sessions at the Fen on only 7 different days in February – the St. Edmund's Fen/Education area and Gallops were each used on 3 days, while the Reedbed, very bleak at this time of year, on just one day. The month's ringing total was 85 (just one fewer than January 2018); a further 121 different birds were retrapped, so the overall total for the month was 206.
