WICKEN FEN (BIRD RINGING) GROUP Brief news for March 2018

There were netting sessions at the Fen on only 7 different days in March – the St. Edmund's Fen/Education area was used on 5 days, and Gallops on 3. The month's ringing total was 82; a further 123 different birds were retrapped, so the overall total for the month was 205.
