Brief news for June 2018

There were netting sessions at the Fen on 9 different days in June (all CES) – with additional nestbox sessions. Area B (Gallops) 3, Area F (Reedbed) 3, Area H (St Edmund's Fen) 3. The month's ringing total was 274; a further 132 different birds were retrapped, so the overall total for the month was 406.
