Brief news for July 2018

There were netting sessions at the Fen on 10 different days in July (CES + Bioblitz day) – with additional nestbox/pulli sessions. Area B (Gallops) 3, Area F (Reedbed) 3, Area H (St Edmund's Fen) 4. The month's ringing total was 366; a further 93 different birds were retrapped, or controlled so the overall total for the month was 459. Interesting reports

Cranes: 2 reported irregularly at both Wicken and Burwell Fens.

Bittern: reported from both Wicken and Burwell Fens.

Breeding records for among others: Shelduck, Gadwall, Tufted Duck and Little Grebe.

Wader passage at Burwell Fen included Wood Sandpiper 1 on the 8th and 2 on the 9th and a Curlew on the 11th, see table for others.

Unsurprisingly given the weather both Baker's Fen water and Burwell Fen were practically dry by the month's end.
