

WICKEN FEN GROUP Brief news for August 2018

There were ringing sessions at the Fen on 9 different days in August (mainly CES) – with additional roost sessions (highlighted). The month's ringing total was 446; a further 56 different birds were retrapped, so the overall total for the month was 502. Interesting observations

By the end of the month both Baker's Fen and Burwell Fen had no open water and this dictated some of the observations (or lack of).

Greylag maximum 240 on the WeBS count on the 16th

Mallard 130+ on West Mere on the 30th.

Shoveler 34 on West Mere on the 30th.

Pintail a pair on West Mere on the 30th.

Garganey singles on two dates.

Cormorant 5 on Wicken Fen and 2 on Burwell Fen on the 16th.

Little Grebe bred on the brick pits – 8 on the WeBS count.

A ringtail possible **Hen Harrier** on Burwell Fen on the 15th.

Black-tailed Godwits up to 6 on several dates.

Common Sandpiper on one or two dates.

Green Sandpiper 1-7 regularly reported.

A **Nuthatch** on the 29th was unusual.

Whinchat on Verrall's Fen on the 30th, and a pair of **Stonechat** on the 26th.
