

## WICKEN FEN GROUP Summary for December 2018

There were ringing sessions at the Fen on 9 different days in December most sessions with feeders and sound lures at the Piggeries and/or Gallop's. The month's ringing total was 261; a further 197 different birds were retrapped, and 1 controlled so the overall total for the month was 459. As a result of pumping and rainfall both Baker's Fen and Burwell Fen had open water for the first time for several months.

Whooper Swan up to 35 on Burwell Fen all month.
Barnacle Goose one on the 2<sup>nd</sup>.
Wigeon maximum 540 on the 9<sup>th</sup>.
Teal c400 on the 9<sup>th</sup>.
Gadwall 164 combined count Baker's and Burwell Fens on the 9<sup>th</sup>.
Cormorant Burwell Fen 7 on the 16<sup>th</sup>.
Slavonian Grebe Burwell Lode on the 27<sup>th</sup>.
Marsh Harrier maximum 4.
Hen Harrier the roost peaked at 3 males and a ringtail.
Crane a pair flew over on the 30<sup>th</sup>.
Dunlin 15 on the 9<sup>th</sup>.
Woodcock one on the 3<sup>rd</sup>.
Short-eared Owl Burwell Fen 1-5 on several dates.
Peregrine on the 16<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>.
Stonechat a female on the 16<sup>th</sup>.
